The trick with these warm hearted Grenache wines is to serve them at the right temperature. They taste fresher and drink better too. Slighty jubey red fruits, spice, cedar, dried mint and rose perfume. Medium to full bodied showing some savoury bottle age complexity, a dusting of fine grainy tannin, a little warmth and an old wood spiced perfumed finish. its a good drink.
