Good honest, flavoursome wines made by Dom Torzi and Tim Freeland.

Has a biscuity smell much like Spicy Fruit Pillows or Full O Fruit, blackberry, chocolate, dusting of spice, and dusty earthy notes too. Full bodied, rich dark fruit, light grainy tannin, a distinct kind of tar and diesel sort of thing going on – hard to describe but a bit locomotive – plump raspberries and a juicy but burnt flavoured finish. Lots of character. Lots of bang per buck. 90 Points.
