Full bodied, bright in its own way, with mixed berries and hazlenut, grainy tannin, neat acidity, and a firm finish of good length. It's a bit rustic, in a good way, and delivers its message surely and well. Rock solid.

Adelaide Plains fruit. Luscious purple fruited style with some surprising mint and then drying, minty tannins. A big mouthful of wine, the luscious fruit offsetting the minty tannins. After the lush Shiraz and classic Grenache this feels a bit raw and minty. But again, that concentration is a winner. Best drinking: will likely be better next year, then up to 10 years.
