It's dry, gently chalky, acidity nicely settled, quite a busy foamy mouth-feel, and a dry finish of solid length, some cracked wheat as it goes. Fresh aperitivo style, delivering a lively, and quite lovely, glass of fizz. Not so complex, but sometimes freshness and energy is the order of the day. I like it.
